

SAFE DATE COMMUNITY GUIDELINES

Effective Date: March 3, 2026

Safe Date is designed to promote respectful connections. These Community Guidelines outline the standards of behavior expected from all users of the Safe Date platform.

By using the Service, you agree to follow these Guidelines in addition to our [Terms of Use](#).

Be respectful. Be honest. Be safe.

1. Be Authentic

Use your real identity and accurate information.

- Do not impersonate another person.
- Do not use false photos.
- Do not create multiple accounts to evade restrictions.

Accounts found to contain false or misleading information may be suspended or removed.

2. Respect Others

Safe Date is not a place for harassment or hostility.

You may not:

- Harass, threaten, or intimidate others
- Send abusive or degrading messages
- Engage in bullying or targeted harassment
- Share private conversations or images without consent

If an interaction makes you uncomfortable, you may block the user and report the behavior.

3. No Hate or Discrimination

We do not tolerate content that promotes:

- Racism
- Sexism
- Homophobia
- Ableism
- Religious discrimination
- Violence against protected groups

Content that promotes hate, violence, or discrimination may result in immediate removal.

4. No Sexual Exploitation or Illegal Conduct

You may not use Safe Date to:

- Solicit prostitution or escort services
- Promote trafficking
- Exchange sexual services for compensation
- Share exploitative or non-consensual content

We may cooperate with law enforcement where required by law.

5. No Fraud or Financial Manipulation

You may not:

- Request money from other users

- Conduct scams or deceptive schemes
- Impersonate financial institutions
- Attempt to obtain sensitive personal information

If someone requests money or financial information, report the account immediately.

6. Nudity and Explicit Content

Profile photos and public content must be appropriate.

We do not allow:

- Explicit sexual images
- Pornographic material
- Graphic sexual descriptions in public profiles

Private communication between consenting adults must still comply with applicable law and these Guidelines.

7. Safety Expectations

While Safe Date may use verification tools to promote safety, we do not guarantee the identity, background, or behavior of users.

Users are responsible for:

- Exercising caution
- Meeting in public places
- Protecting personal information

Always prioritize your safety.

8. Reporting Violations

You may report violations of these Guidelines using the in-app reporting tools.

We may:

- Review reported content
- Remove violating material
- Suspend or terminate accounts

We reserve discretion in enforcement decisions.

9. Enforcement

Violations of these Guidelines may result in:

- Content removal
- Account suspension
- Permanent account termination

Severe violations may result in immediate removal without warning.

10. Changes to These Guidelines

We may update these Community Guidelines periodically. Continued use of the Service after changes constitutes acceptance of the revised Guidelines.
