This Cookie Policy explains how Safe Date (“Safe Date,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) uses cookies and similar technologies when you use our website, mobile application, and related services (collectively, the “Service”).

By continuing to use the Service, you consent to the use of cookies and similar technologies as described in this Policy, subject to your browser settings and applicable law.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help websites function properly, remember preferences, analyze performance, and enhance user experience. We may also use similar technologies, including:

- Web beacons
- Pixels
- Local storage
- Device identifiers

These technologies may collect information about your device and usage activity.

2. Types of Cookies and Technologies We Use

A. Essential Cookies

Essential cookies are necessary for the Service to operate properly. These cookies enable:

- Account login and authentication
- Security protections
- Session management
- Fraud prevention

Without these cookies, certain features of the Service may not function correctly.

B. Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how users interact with the Service by collecting information such as:

- Time spent on pages
- Device and browser type
- General geographic location (e.g., city or region)

We may use third-party analytics providers to assist with collecting and analyzing this information. Analytics providers process information on our behalf and are contractually restricted from using it for unauthorized purposes.

C. Functional Cookies

Functional cookies allow the Service to remember your preferences and settings, such as:

- Language preferences
- Login details
- Interface settings

These cookies improve user experience but are not strictly necessary for core functionality.

D. Advertising and Measurement Technologies

We may use limited advertising, measurement, or engagement technologies to:

- Understand user engagement
- Improve marketing effectiveness
- Measure campaign performance

Safe Date does not sell personal information for monetary compensation.

Certain privacy laws define “sharing” broadly to include some analytics or advertising-related data transfers. Where applicable, users may exercise opt-out rights as described below.

We use cookies and similar technologies to:
